Marigold Garland

Materials:

- Tissue paper in orange and yellow
- Pipe cleaners
- Scissors
- Yarn

Instructions:



 Stack six sheets of tissue paper each measuring 6" long and 4" tall.



2. Fold them accordion style.



3. Cut a pipe cleaner in half. Wrap one of the halves around the center of the tissue paper, making sure to leave one end of the pipe cleaner free. This will become your stem.



4. Fan out the tissue paper.
Holding the center, pull the top
sheet up toward the center on
both sides to create petals. Start
on the side where the pipe cleaner
is folded down to leave the stem
free.



5. Repeat with each sheet until the flower is complete.

Using the previous steps, make as many flowers as you want for your garland.



6. When all of your flowers are finished, lay the yarn out on the table. This is the base of your garland.

Turn a flower over so that the pipe cleaner is sticking up.



7. Place the flower where you want it on the yarn. Twist the pipe cleaner to secure it on the yarn.



8. Repeat with all of your flowers and enjoy your garland!
