

Paper Plate Calavera Mask

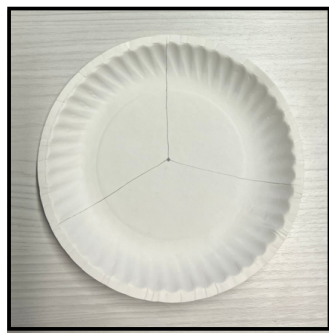
Materials:

- Paper plate
- Craft stick
- Pencil
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
- Sequins/beads/gemstones (optional)

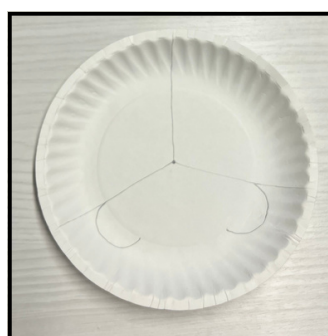
Instructions:



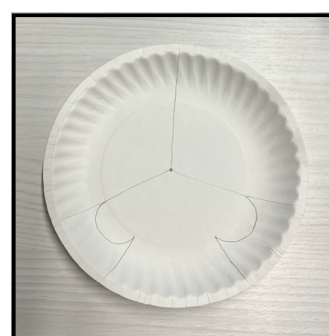
1. Using a pencil, mark the center of the plate with a dot.



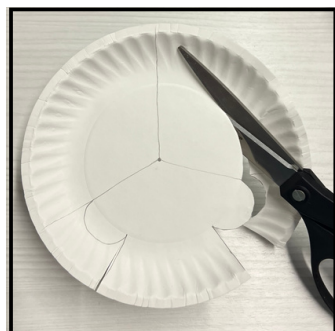
2. Imagine the plate as a clock and draw lines from the center at 4, 8, and 12 o'clock. This should divide your plate into thirds.



3. In the bottom third, draw two semi-circles from the inner rim of the plate where you want your skeleton cheeks to be.



4. Draw lines from the inner point of the skeleton cheeks to the edge of the plate to form the skeleton mouth.



5. Cut out your skeleton head using the inner circle of the plate as a guide for the top of the skull. .



6. Using a black marker, draw the eyes and nose, and teeth of your skull.

Tip: Draw an upside-down heart for the nose!



7. Decorate your calaveras using colored markers! Try to keep both sides symmetrical, as that is how real-life calaveras usually are!

Optional: Embellish your calaveras using sequins or gemstones.



8. Glue the craft stick to the back of the skull and enjoy your mini calavera mask!
